# YOUR CENTRE DESPERATELY NEEDS YOUR HELP TO SURVIVE

With a new executive in place we are begging for people to come forward to help us out. Our old executive worked countless hours keeping the centre running but the new executive admits we will need lots of help and volunteers to keep our centre running. Some rolls that need filling:

<u>Bingo Organizer</u> – The Delta Bingo provides a large source of income to our centre however, sadly if we cannot find volunteers to run and work this we will have no choice but to give it up. *This is an urgent need,* we have until the end of July to fill this position or we will likely need to withdraw from the Delta Bingo.

Along with the need for someone to coordinate the aspects of volunteering for the Delta Bingo and to schedule volunteers, we also need <u>Bingo Volunteers</u> – we need people to work the bingo for a couple of hours on a Sunday afternoon –we currently work about 2 Sundays a month so if we get 12 -15 names of people you will work we will only need to work it once every few months.

<u>Property Manager</u> - The Rankin Centre requires someone to coordinate the property maintenance and what needs to be addressed in order to keep our centre functioning for our community!

<u>Property Maintainers</u> - We also need people who will help the property manager to do various property maintenance items – please let us know what you can do to take care of your centre! <u>Bartender Coordinator</u> - We need someone to be responsible for lining up bartenders for events!

<u>Bartenders</u> – As you are aware, we always need bartenders – and we can train anyone over 18 for this job – we will help you get your smart serve – *this is a great position that you can even make a little money from some tips.* Once again, with numerous people involved this makes for a very easy position.
