

Memorial Scholarship 2017/2018

Two scholarship of \$1000.00 each will be awarded to students who have successfully completed a high school program and have been accepted to a post-secondary institution in a human medical field or social work.

WHO QUALIFIES

Canadian Citizen in their final year of high school who have demonstrated community enhancement by doing volunteer work.

- To qualify applicants must provide documentation outlining their volunteer work over the years they attended high school. This scholarship deems volunteering very essential.
- Documents must provide details as to the type of volunteer work that was carried out, what organizations benefited, what type of programs were involved. Please include a breakdown of the amount of hours spent volunteering at each organization. Letters from the organizations are encouraged.
- Volunteer work at the Rankin Centre an asset but not necessarily a deciding factor.
- Applicants will be reviewed by the Rankin Centre Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants must attend Fellowes High School, Bishop Smith High School, Opeongo High School, Jeanne-Lajoie or Ecole Equinoxe Publique.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicant must apply to RCRC by May 1st and be pursuing post-secondary studies starting in September of the same year.
- Transcripts of marks must be provided covering all years.
- Mid term marks for the final year must be forwarded with the application
- All information must be supplied in a timely manner so that successful applicants can be notified and presented with their scholarship at their graduation ceremony.
- All applicants must apply using the **RCRC application form**.
