## Memorial Scholarship 2020-2021

Two scholarships of \$1000 each may be awarded to students who have successfully completed a high school program, have been accepted to a post-secondary institution and who exemplify a true commitment to their community through active volunteerism.

**WHO QUALIFIES?** Canadian Citizen, in their final year of high school who have enriched their community by doing volunteer work. To qualify, the applicant must provide:

- Documentation outlining their volunteer work over the years they attended high school. The scholarship committee deems volunteering very essential.
- Documentation must include the details of the type of volunteer work that has been carried out, what organization benefited and what types of programs were involved. Please include a breakdown of the number of hours spent volunteering at each organization. Letters from the organizations are encouraged.
- Volunteer work at the Rankin Centre is an asset, but not mandatory
- Applicants must attend Fellowes, Bishop Smith, Opeongo, Jeanne-Lajoie or École Equinoxe Publique.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

- All applications will be reviewed by the Rankin Centre Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants must submit their completed applications by May 1, 2021 and be pursuing post-secondary studies starting in September 2021.
- Transcripts of marks must be provided covering all years.
- Mid-term marks for the final year must be forwarded with the application.
- All information must be supplied in a timely manner so that successful applicants can be notified and presented with their scholarship at their graduation ceremony.
- Applicants must apply using the RCRC application form.
