SMART SERVE RECERTIFICATION

The Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario (AGCO) has introduced a five-year term for all new and existing liquor training certifications. This means that everyone must complete the Smart Serve training program every five years. Anyone with a smart serve certificate issued prior to July 1, 2018 will have to recertify by June 30, 2023, which is when they expire.

This course can be taken online. Of course there will be a charge for this and the Rankin Centre will help out with this.
