Green's Hotel - Part 2

After the war in 1922 and 1923, John Lau and his wife lived at the hotel before moving to Pembroke. Adolf Grife had bought the property to supply logs for sawing at the mill. In 1925, the Orangemen acquired more land from him to build a larger hall. In 1931 the Grife family moved to this log house after a fire had destroyed their residence near the sawmill. Their new home was built within a year.

The log house had renters, the Boxes, Leslie Green, the cheesemaker and his Hilliard wife. Guest and family operating the Rankin switchboard from 1937-1942, later Mr. & Mrs. George Risto. In 1947, Lorne Grife and Gerhart Grife owned the lot. The building was removed. The Institute Hall dismantled in 1972 and the Grifes donated frontage for the Community Club to establish a rink, baseball diamond and recreation hall. In 1982, Mrs. Lorne Grife sold the remaining land to friends, Mr. & Mrs. Carl Stager of Kitchener. A new home was built there.
